JAID volunteers adopt a set of classrooms at a local elementary or middle school and, in teams of two, deliver a JA program consisting of five+ 30 to 45-minutes sessions in one school day. JA's programs are centered around financial health, career readiness, or entrepreneurial thinking and include fun games and engaging activities designed to mesh into each grade level's state and national standards.
