Teachers organize their classrooms into teams who solve a common problem by creating a product or service. Teachers lead the students through lessons about the entrepreneurial thinking process, where they experience the steps needed to get a business idea off the ground. Students then develop "Shark-Tank"-like pitches to sell their ideas to big-time investors. This is where JA volunteers step-in.

The Volunteer Experience


