JA What Comes Next prepares 9th-12th grade students for life after graduation and answers their most pressing question, “What comes next?”

Current students at 4 and 2-year colleges, servicemembers, work apprentices and young people who immediately entered the workforce after high school will discuss their decisions and their transformation to life after graduation. (“Type” of presenter is based on availability.)

How It Works

The program will be divided into a five-part Career Quest: **Q**uestion, **U**nderstand, **E**xplore, **S**elect, and **T**ransform.

Presenters and students will be given a worksheet with topics and question prompts to help them prepare to discuss each section of their post-secondary path, including self-reflection, research, and prioritization of their needs, wants, and values.

High school students may submit questions before the event. If there is extra time, additional questions may be asked.
