The program will be divided into a five-part Career Quest: **Q**uestion, **U**nderstand, **E**xplore, **S**elect, and **T**ransform.

Panelists will share how they engaged in self-reflection and exploration in high school to better understand themselves and how that "work" helped prepare them to select a path and transform into What Came Next.

High school students may submit questions prior to the event. If there is extra time, additional questions may be asked.
